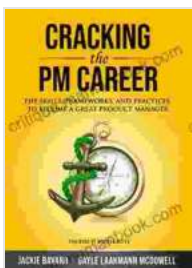
What Does a PM Do?

consider getting an MBA or MS in product management.

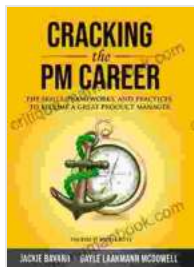
- **Gain experience in software development or engineering.** This will give you the technical skills you need to be a successful PM. You can gain experience through internships, part-time jobs, or volunteer work.

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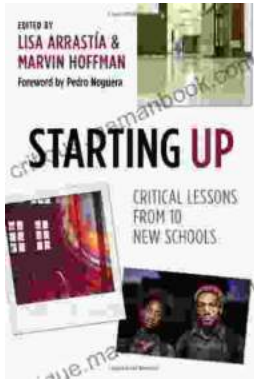
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
