## Baby Boy Outfit And Blanket Afghan

This crochet pattern is for a baby boy outfit and blanket afghan. The outfit includes a hat, booties, and sweater. The blanket afghan is a simple granny square pattern. All of the pieces are made with worsted weight yarn and a size H crochet hook.

- Worsted weight yarn in blue, white, and gray
- Size H crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Buttons (optional)

Round 1: Chain 4, join with a slip stitch to form a ring. Chain 1, single crochet 11 times into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first single
crochet. (12 sc)

Round 2: Chain 1, single crochet 2 times into each single crochet around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (24 sc)

Round 3: Chain 1, *single crochet 2 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (36 sc)

Round 4: Chain 1, *single crochet 3 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (48 sc)

Round 5: Chain 1, *single crochet 4 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (60 sc)

Round 6: Chain 1, *single crochet 5 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (72 sc)

Round 7: Chain 1, *single crochet 6 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (84 sc)

Round 8: Chain 1, *single crochet 7 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (96 sc)

Round 9: Chain 1, *single crochet 8 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (108 sc)

Round 10: Chain 1, *single crochet 9 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (120 sc)

Round 11: Chain 1, *single crochet 10 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (132 sc)

Round 12: Chain 1, *single crochet 11 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (144 sc)

Round 13: Chain 1, *single crochet 12 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (156 sc)

Round 14: Chain 1, *single crochet 13 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (168 sc)

Round 15: Chain 1, *single crochet 14 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (180 sc)

Round 16: Chain 1, *single crochet 15 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join
with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (192 sc)

Round 17: Chain 1, *single crochet 16 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (204 sc)

Round 18: Chain 1, *single crochet 17 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (216 sc)

Round 19: Chain 1, *single crochet 18 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (228 sc)

Round 20: Chain 1, *single crochet 19 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (240 sc)

Round 21: Chain 1, *single crochet 20 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet. (252 sc)

Round 22: Chain 1, *single crochet 21 times into the next single crochet, single crochet once into the next single crochet; repeat from *
